### Twenty-Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time, October 8, 2023 "He will lease his vineyard to other tenants." Matthew 21: 33-43

### Dear Parishioners:

The image of God as a vineyard keeper continues this week. This parable shows that God' life-giving and saving work does not end when human wickedness tries to stand in its way. Amidst all the pain and brokenness and suffering of this world, God finds ways to continue to give life and bear fruit. God is persistent, not only in carrying out God's plans but also in loving us. God wins and will have final victory, even when it is not apparent. And because God is always on our side, this is very good news.

Last Wednesday, over 250 priests from the Diocese of Brooklyn gathered with Bishop Brennan for our Fall Convocation. The theme was: "A Shepherd among Shepherd, a Bishop with his Priests." Bishop Brennan has begun a process for Pastoral Planning for the Diocese. In beginning this process, we must also look at the current data and statistics (see the chart below).

### 37 Seminarians at various stages of formation

Bishop Brennan is involving the priests of the Diocese to be part of the discussion. We had round table Deanery discussions, to reflect the local communities. Each Deanery looked at the number of people attending mass at each parish, the number of Baptisms, First Holy Communion, Confirmation, Weddings, Anointings, and Funerals. In addition, the number of children enrolled in Faith Formation, and catechists. We were asked what do the numbers say about our deanery? About our parish? What are the critical factors to consider in planning for the future? How can the Mass schedule in each parish be adjusted taking into consideration: lower number of assigned priests, lower number of parishioners, and parishioners' complex schedules. How did we assess the Religious Education program in our deanery? What do we need for Bishop Brennan and his Diocesan Team to do to prepare for the future?

The discussion has begun. Some parishes may enter into partnerships, change Mass schedules (as we did), and more collaborations of pastoral programs i.e., Faith Formation, O.C.I.A. and others. Let us continue to pray for one another as this discussion begins and the process continues, as we will all be affected by this process., for this I wanted to share with you this information.


