The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ **Corpus** Christi June 2, 2024 "This is my body." This is my blood." Mark 14: 12-16, 22-26

Dear Parishioners:

"While they were eating, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, gave it to them, and said, 'Take it; this is my body.

Today's gospel gives us an account of the institution of the Eucharist. The pattern established here continues at every Mass; we take bread, bless it, and share it. We recall all of Jesus' incredible gifts, the Eucharist, the Holy Spirit, his very death, and resurrection. Through him we are given abundant life that cannot be destroyed by death. In the light of all these plentiful gifts we do well to remember that the word Eucharist means "thanksgiving." Giving is the very nature of God; it is what God does and what God is. It is a response of gratitude that God asks of us, and we offer it in the celebration of the Eucharist.

In this weekend's Responsorial Psalm, we sing in thanksgiving for the gift of our redemption in Christ. We promise to be faithful servants, taking the cup of salvation in the same way Christ did: as blood to be poured out for others. As we share in Christ's Body and Blood, we surrender ourselves to be more like Christ: bread and wine for our broken world today.

Christ's body and blood serve as fuel so that we might go out and live into our God-given callings with energy and spirit. The grace broken and poured at the altar extends out into the world. Strengthened by Christ's body and blood, we will enjoy the fullness of everlasting life with Christ.

May this solemnity inspire us to examine our lives to see where we are being called to pour out ourselves in service and self-sacrifice.

Next weekend, Sunday, June 9th, the Feast of St. Ephrem, we will have a Mass of Thanksgiving at the 11:00 am Mass in Honor of the Sisters of St. Ephrem Convent and Fr. Nicholas Colalella.
