July 21, 2024

"He began to send them out."

Mark 6: 7-13

Dear Parishioners:

Today's gospel highlights the importance of the Sabbath practice. Jesus tells the apostles: "Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while." The Son of God recognizes that daily life demands a lot from disciples then and now. The to-do list never stops growing. Our calling may pull us in many directions a reality that makes the practice of Sabbath even more necessary. To pause from work and worry, if even for an afternoon, can renew energy for the day-to-day grind. To worship, withdraw, wonder, walk and welcome others draws us closer to God.

We might feel some pity for Jesus here, after a busy stretch of ministry he attempts to retreat with the apostles only to find that the crowds have walked to meet them. But his response is not one of annoyance or impatience, justified as those reactions would be. He rather sees the need of those who are seeking him, and he responds to that need with compassion. He is able to do so in part because he does not operate from a scarcity mindset. It seems there is not enough time for both ministry and rest, but Jesus operates from a place of trust. In God his needs and ours will be abundantly met, and Jesus is able to share that generosity with those who are seeking him.

Jesus' heart is moved with "pity" for the crowds. This is perhaps better translated as compassion or mercy. Jesus sees in the crowds a deep hunger for a shepherd, someone to lead them into the promise of a better tomorrow. The Son of God allows himself to be interrupted by the needs of the crowd.

Are You Being Called to be a Deacon?



A deacon is a man who is called by God and after discernment, formation, and preparation is ordained by his bishop to serve the needs of God's people. If a married man is called to the diaconate, his wife must consent and support his decision to seek formation and ordination. As Catholics, we believe that each ordained deacon is conformed through

the sacramental grace of Holy Orders into the image of Jesus the Servant.

Threefold Service of a Deacon

- Service to the Word of God: the deacon is called to be a man of deep prayer, becoming familiar with and a living witness to the Word of God in his ministry, among his family, and in the workplace.
- Service to the Eucharist: Every deacon is called to serve the sacrament of Christ's Body and Blood by his proper participation in the Liturgy, his love and reverence of the Blessed Sacrament, and his willingness to bring the Eucharist to those who are sick and unable to join the community of faith in Sunday worship.
- Service on behalf of Justice, Charity, and Peace: Deacons serve as Christ's heralds of hope and love to the poor, disabled, needy, lonely, young, forgotten, and society's outcasts.

This fall there are two evenings of inquiry scheduled for men who are interested in the Diaconate in the Diocese of Brooklyn.


